This Special Care Dentistry Summit Meeting aims to educate Arizona dental health practitioners on how to accept and treat the special needs patient with compassion, accommodation, respect and empathy in their practice. The identified population for this course is Arizona's special needs children, aged birth to 18 years. At each region's summit meeting, dentists and support staff will receive pre-and post- session questionnaires covering a range of topics to gauge interest, current knowledge and self-rated experience levels with the special needs youth patient.

## Course Objectives

- Educate dental professionals on the state of oral health care delivery to the special needs population in Arizona.
- Remove barriers concerning adequate financial reimbursement by educating dental professionals on how to access ALTCS funds for special care dental treatment benefits.
- Examine the level of knowledge /experience Arizona dentists possess treating this population.
- Examine the level of support staff knowledge/experience with the special needs population.
- Educate dentists and support staff on how to treat special care patients.
